# Change/Cancellation of Commercial/Fishing Ship Registration Particulars

## NOTES:

### Where the change of particulars involves –

- Change of limits - an accredited marine surveyor or designer should be consulted as new Certificates of Compliance may be required
- Further building - an accredited marine surveyor or designer must be consulted (refer to the Maritime Safety Queensland web site for an explanation of what constitutes 'further building')
- Change of address – evidence of identity confirming the new address must be produced

Where a change of address involves an address other than a Queensland address there is a need to confirm a connection to Queensland in order to maintain Queensland registration. In such a case there must be evidence that the ship is operating in Queensland waters and is owned by –

- A person whose place of business, or principal place of business, is in Queensland; or
- A person whose principal place of business for managing the ship's operations is in Queensland
