

# QUEENSLAND NOTICE TO MARINERS 717 (Temporary) of 2006

---

## TOWNSVILLE PILOTAGE AREAS

**LOCALITY: DUCK POND**

**ACTIVITY: GEOTECHNICAL MONITORING – TEMPORARY  
STRUCTURES**

Mariners are advised that two temporary structures are to be established in the area known as the Duck Pond to the east of the Breakwater Marina Channel for the purposes of monitoring ground water in the seabed. The structures will be positioned in the following locations and lit at night by yellow flashing lights as detailed below.

**Site A** approximate position;

latitude 19° 14.47' S

longitude 146° 49.67' E

flashing sequence Fl.Y (2.5)s

**Site B** approximate position;

latitude 19° 14.65' S

longitude 146° 49.9' E

flashing sequence Fl.Y (4.0)s

Establishment of the structures is expected to be completed on Friday, 3 November 2006 and they will remain in place for a period of approximately 12 months.

Mariners are advised to keep clear of the structures and navigate with caution in the area.
