Queensland Notices to Mariners



188 (Temporary) of 2010

Townsville pilotage area

Locality: Berth No. 7, Townsville Port

Activity: berthing restrictions

Refer to notice: 321 (T) of 2006

Mariners are advised that the following restrictions apply to vessels berthing at No. 7 berth, Townsville.

- Vessels berthing at Berth No. 7 cannot be longer than 190 metres in length.
- Berthing displacement is not to be greater than 40,000 tonnes.
- Two tugs must be utilised when berthing ships at Berth No. 7 regardless of LOA.
- All berthing at Berth No. 7 must occur during day light hours.
- All berthing at Berth No. 7 must occur when wind speed is less than 15 knots.
- The combined beam of ships berthed at Berths No. 7 and 8 cannot be greater than 50 metres.
- Berth 7 is only to be used by operational vessels.
- Access to Berth No. 7 during the berthing of ships is not permitted unless such access is absolutely necessary for operational purposes.
- Live loading on Berth No. 7 is not permitted on the deck during any berthing or mooring operation.
