



Application for an Order directing the issue of a Restricted Marine Licence

Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994

This form is to be used by you when you have been convicted of an offence mentioned under s202D(1) of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act* (the Act), and you **are eligible** to apply to a court for an order directing that you be issued with a restricted licence. You will need to complete this application before the court hearing and give the application to the Magistrate **immediately** after you have been found guilty and before the Magistrate disqualifies you from holding or obtaining a marine licence.

Eligibility to apply for a restricted licence (please read carefully)

1. You are **only eligible** to apply if, when you committed the offence:
 - a. You were the holder of a Queensland issued marine licence.
2. You are **not eligible** to apply if, within the last five years before making this application:
 - a. You were disqualified from holding or obtaining a marine licence.
 - b. A licence you held was suspended or cancelled.
 - c. You were previously convicted in Queensland of an offence mentioned in s202A(1)(a) of the Act.
 - d. You were previously convicted elsewhere of any offence that would have been an offence mentioned in s202A(1)(a) of the Act if committed in Queensland.

Note: Your eligibility to apply for a restricted licence is not affected by a suspension, cancellation or disqualification:

- that was set aside on appeal
- imposed because of a mental or physical disability.

3. You are also **not eligible** to apply if, when the offence for which you have been convicted was committed while:
 - a. You were engaged in an activity directly connected with your means of earning your livelihood.
 - b. You were operating a ship while not holding the required licence.
 - c. You held a restricted licence.
 - d. You were operating an air cushion vehicle or class 1 passenger vessel (other than a hire and drive vessel).

Important information

The court **will not** grant the application for an order directing the issue of a restricted licence to you unless you are able to **satisfy the court that:**

- a. You are an appropriate person to hold a restricted licence, having regard to the safety of other ship operators and the public generally.
- b. A refusal to make the order would cause extreme hardship to you or your family by depriving you of your means of earning a living.
