

WARNING FOR VESSELS NEAR THE PORT OF HAY POINT RESTRICTED AREAS



Carlisle Island
Brampton Island

Keswick Island
St Bees Island
Scawfell Island

Unauthorised vessels prohibited from mooring, anchoring, manoeuvring in Restricted Area "A".

Only transit Restricted Area "B" when there are no large ships in the channel.

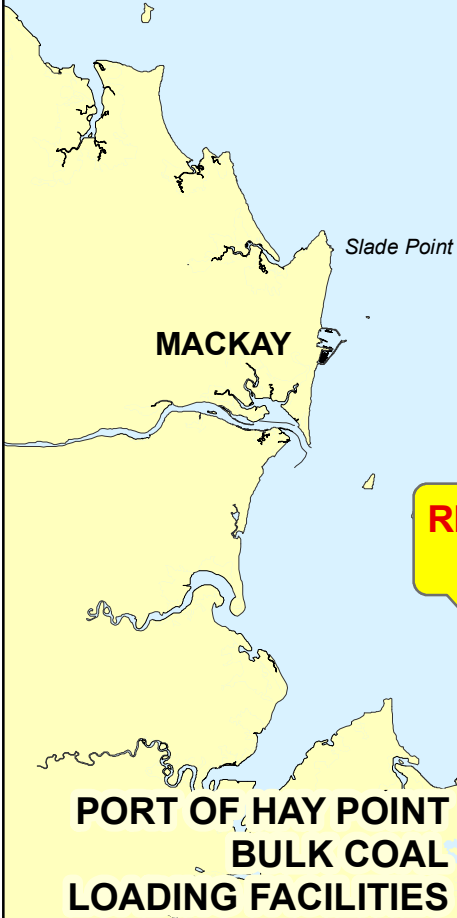
Cross the Restricted Area "B" at 90° and at best speed. Do not loiter in Restricted Area "B".

Keep a proper lookout at all times. Know your responsibility.

Even though you may have right of way, let good seamanship prevail and give all ships a wide berth.

Large ships at maximum draft can only manoeuvre within the channel. Keep well clear.

Always show correct running lights at night. Extinguish floodlights or deck lights when approaching the Port area

Monitor VHF radio channel 16 at all times.
Monitor VHF radio channel 10 to listen only for local shipping traffic.
Hay Point (VTS) Vessel Traffic Service can be contacted by phone 4956 3489 to find out about shipping movements in the area.
Report to Hay Point VTS your intention to cross Restricted Area "B" on VHF 10 or by phone.
