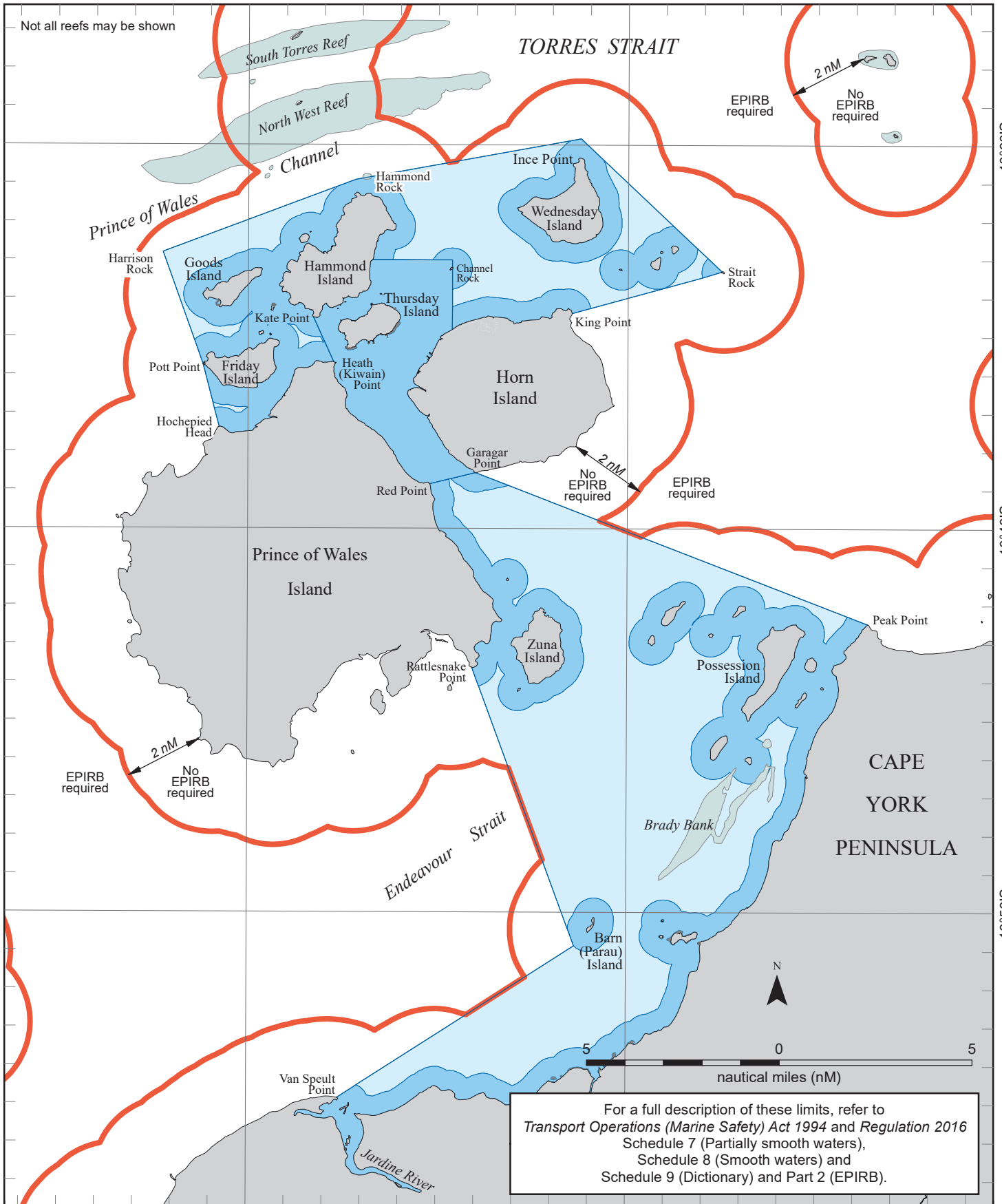

"Smooth waters" (as described in Schedule 9) means the waters-

- of rivers, creeks, streams and lakes; or
- within breakwaters or revetments; or
- described in Schedule 7 that are within 0.5 nautical mile from land; or
- described in Schedule 8.

"Partially smooth waters" means the waters-

- described in Schedule 7, other than waters within 0.5 nautical mile from land.

- Smooth waters
- The EPIRB 2 nautical mile limit may not be shown for every island due to scale but still applies to any land above highest water mark.
