


WARNING FOR SMALL VESSELS ENTERING AND LEAVING MACKAY HARBOUR AND MARINA



SHIP NAVIGATION AREA
ALL SMALL VESSELS ARE TO KEEP WELL CLEAR WHEN A SHIP IS IN THIS AREA

WARNINGS and ADVICE

1. **RED TRAFFIC LIGHTS** (shown as ) indicate a ship is manoeuvring. **DO NOT** proceed past this point or enter the harbour.
2. Large ships can only manoeuvre in limited areas. **Keep well clear.**
3. Monitor VHF radio channel 16 at all times.
4. Keep a proper lookout at all times.
5. Listen for sound signals as follows:
 - **ONE LONG BLAST** from a ship indicates the ship is entering or leaving the harbour. **Keep clear.**
 - **FIVE SHORT BLASTS** indicate you are impeding the passage of a ship. **Move away immediately and keep well clear.**
